**OFFICE ORDER**

**Subject: - Re-constitution of Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) for online Counselling for Super Speciality, Post Graduate (50%), Under Graduate (15%), Deemed and Central Universities/Institutions.**

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The 'Scheme' approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Medical Examination Cell of Directorate General of Health Services has been entrusted with the responsibility to conduct online counselling for allotment of Under Graduate seats to the candidate under 15% All India Quota and Post Graduate seats to the candidate under 50% All India Quota every year. Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in its letter dated 04.05.2017 has directed to DGHS for conducting common counselling Super Speciality seats at National level from 2017-18 onwards.

2. The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide Order dated 09.05.2017 in WP (C) No.267/2017 – Dar-UR-Slam Educational Trust and Ors. V/s Medical Council of India and Others has given additional responsibility to DGHS for conducting common counselling for allotment of Under Graduate (MBBS/BDS) seats available in Medical/Dental Colleges of Deemed Universities of the country which have seats with All India Character from the current academic year 2017-18 onwards.

3. NEET-Super Speciality, NEET-Post Graduate and NEET-Under Graduate on All India basis including and Deemed University with All India Character course are being conducted by National Board of Examinations (NBE) and Central Board of Secondary Examination (CBSE) respectively for admission to SS, PG and UG and Deemed Universities. The seats of SS, PG and UG will be filled up on the basis of result of these examinations by the MCC. The Medical Counselling Committee 2018 is hereby constituted as under with immediate effect:

i.	Special DG (Medical Education)	Chairman
ii.	Deputy Director General (Medical)	Member
iii.	Assistant Director General (Medical Education)	Member Secretary
iv.	Director, Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi	Member
v.	Principal, VMMC & Safdarjang Hospital, New Delhi	Member
vi.	Nominee of National Informatics Centre(NIC), New Delhi	Member
vii.	Nominee of National Board of Examinations(NBE), New Delhi	Member
viii.	Nominee of Central Board of Secondary Examination(CBSE), Delhi	Member

4. The MCC shall be responsible for allocation of seats to be filled up on All India basis as per the result of NEET-Super Speciality, NEET-PG and NEET-UG, in participating Colleges/Institutions. For this purpose, the MCC shall ensure compilation and wide dissemination of information relating to institutions, highlighting peculiar learning environment in each of the Institute, where ever applicable.

5. An updated Medical Counselling Committee of the following members, whose tenure will be for a period of at least 3 years. And if some member of the committee retires/transfers from the Head

quarter/Government Institute, the proposal can be reviewed and a fresh committee can be framed in between, if needed. The MCC- 2018 onwards would be especially responsible for:

- a. Finalisation of counselling procedure and schedule.
- b. Finalisation of counselling centres and making necessary arrangements at the counselling centres. If applicable.
- c. Printing of brochure-cum-option form.
- d. Maintenance of web site.
- e. Fixation of counselling fees and deposits, if any.
- f. Distribution and collection of option forms.
- g. Coordination with the concerned agencies for counselling against State/UT quota seats.
- h. Matters, including court cases transferred to MCC-2018
- i. Work relating to audit of funds to be placed under its disposal.
- j. Any other task(s) related to counselling and allocation of seats against All India quota.

6. It also ensured that the MCC-2018 would meet as often as required and will hold its regular meetings with participating Institutions/Colleges to facilitate close interaction and co-ordination. However, as a matter of policy, committee shall abide by the directions of Hon'ble Supreme court, issued from time to time.

7. For the above purposes, MCC-2018 shall meet as often as required. The Committee shall hold its extended meetings with all or some of the participating institutions/Govt. Colleges to facilitate close interaction and coordination. All participating institutions/Govt. Colleges shall provide the committee necessary assistance as may be required by it. On matter of policy, committee shall abide by the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, issued from time to time.

8. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India.
